Community Events, maintenance of all the council's assets such as playparks/cemetery/allotments/buildings etc, a comprehensive painting plan for Quedgeley Community Centre, new flooring for Kingsway Community Centre, deep cleaning of Kingsway Community Centre and supporting the very successful Community Pantry to name a few. The new financial year sees more projects on the horizon. The council seeks to provide

additional equipment to Druids Oak Playpark, improve the condition of Bristol Road Playpark, new doors for Waterwells Sports Centre, additional Health & Safety measures for Kingsway Community Centre and a painting plan now for Kingsway Community Centre. Financial support remains ongoing for the Community Pantry as well as renovations to the previous Quedgeley Social Club premises to ensure it is habitable for future bookings.

As always, the budget has been carefully considered as your councillors are keen for business to continue as normal, whilst remaining mindful of the financial pressures faced by our residents. All our events will continue with the popular Easter Egg Hunt at the Quedgeley Nature Reserve on Easter Monday, our Dog Show event on Sunday 8th June at Kingsway Sports Pavilion, our Fireworks event on Saturday 8th November and our Christmas event on Sunday 14th December at the Kingsway Sports Pavilion. All these events are either free or very cheap to attend, our main focus being that we want to provide as much opportunity for our residents to come together and feel like a community.

Do not forget that local residents who reside in Quedgeley/Kingsway continue to receive a favoured rate when booking our facilities as a thank you for your loyalty and to reflect the fact that these facilities are on your doorstep.
