Competition rules

This is a competition to design a poster to discourage littering in the City of Gloucester. There are two categories of the competition which will be judged independently of each other, and a winner will be chosen from each category:

Category 1: ages 5 to 7 inclusive Category 2: ages 8 to 11 inclusive

The two winning designs will be professionally printed, reproduced onto A4 or A3-size correx signs and displayed around Gloucester and may also be published as part of the publicity around the competition.

The winner in the 5 to 7 age group will win four tickets to an 11am Saturday morning family film at Gloucester Guildhall, Eastgate Street, Gloucester and a 'goody bag.'

The winner in the 8 to 11 age group will win three tickets to the Lego Brick History Exhibition, Gloucester Museum, Brunswick Road, Gloucester and a 'goody bag.'

No alternative prizes will be offered

All entrants must be aged 5 - 11

All entrants must attend school in Gloucester City

Only one entry per person will be allowed

The poster must be A4 and in portrait orientation only

The poster must include an anti-litter slogan

Materials that are easily replicated must be used. For example; felt tip pen, pencil, paints, crayons.

Entries must be received no later than 5pm Friday 12th July 2024. Entries received after this time will not be included.
